Key Responsibilities

- Independently operate a textile sampling line (warping, warp preparation, weaving).
- Adjust machine settings during production (pre-defined by the R&D department) to achieve the expected product quality.
- Perform quality checks on both large production batches and samples.
- Produce and properly document completed production runs.
- Analyse the root causes of breakdowns or unplanned stoppages and report identified issues.
- Strictly apply the 5S methodology (workstation organization and cleanliness) and ensure regular cleaning of production lines.
- Manage production scrap and waste.
- Strictly comply with all safety regulations.
- Actively contribute to the continuous improvement of production lines in collaboration with the entire team.
